WHAT IS ON-THE-JOB TRAINING (OJT)

On-the-Job Training (OJT) is a federally funded program that provides central Ohio job seekers with training to gain specific skills that fit the needs of employers in various industries.

WHO SHOULD APPLY?

You may be a strong candidate for the OJT program if you have been unemployed for 158 days or longer for one of the following reasons:

- You were laid off due to down sizing, or company closure
- Lost employment due to no fault of your own
- You are a homemaker forced back into the workplace due to an economic change
- You are no longer able to maintain self-employment due to economic conditions
